

INFORMATION CLAUSE  
29TH ANNUAL ESDAR CONFERENCE & 4TH ECAR SYMPOSIUM

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), we hereby inform you that:

- 1) Data Controller: The controller of your personal data is the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, with its registered office at: ul. Oczapowskiego 2, 10-719 Olsztyn, Poland, e-mail: [rektor@uwm.edu.pl](mailto:rektor@uwm.edu.pl).
- 2) Data Protection Officer: The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted via e-mail at: [bkw@uwm.edu.pl](mailto:bkw@uwm.edu.pl).
- 3) Purposes and Legal Basis of Processing: Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
  - a. Organizing, managing, and conducting the 29th Annual ESDAR Conference & 4th ECAR Symposium, including creating a list of participants, providing organizational updates, issuing certificates of attendance, advertising and promotional purposes related to the conference, and providing information about future editions of the conference – based on your consent (Legal basis: Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR);
  - b. Concluding a contract (including the acceptance of terms and conditions and ticket purchase), followed by the proper performance of the contract and fulfillment of legal obligations related to invoicing, accounting, etc. (Legal basis: Art. 6(1)(b) and (c) GDPR).
- 4) Image Rights: Please be advised that participation in the Conference constitutes your consent (Legal basis: Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR) to the dissemination of your image in the scope of the conference live-streaming and the publication of photos and recordings of the conference on the Controller's websites and social media (i.e., Facebook, Instagram). We ensure that your image will not be used for commercial purposes; therefore, you are not entitled to any claims, in particular, the right to remuneration.
- 5) Voluntary Provision of Data: Providing your personal data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the conference.
- 6) Your Rights: In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the right to:
  - a. Access your personal data (obtaining confirmation whether we process your data and information regarding such processing);
  - b. Rectify your data if it is incorrect or incomplete;
  - c. Erase your personal data ("right to be forgotten");
  - d. Restrict the processing of your personal data;
  - e. Object to the processing of your data;
  - f. Withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (if processing is based on consent).
  - g. The rights listed above (a-f) can be exercised by contacting the Controller.
- 7) Data Recipients: The recipients of your personal data will only be entities authorized by law. Your data may also be transferred to entities processing personal data on behalf of the Controller, e.g., conference organizers and patrons, IT service providers, and other entities processing data for purposes specified by the Controller – provided that such entities process data solely based on an agreement with the Controller.
- 8) Storage Period: Personal data will be processed no longer than necessary for the proper organization of the conference, until consent is withdrawn, or until an objection to processing is filed.
- 9) Right to Lodge a Complaint: You have the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO) – if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
- 10) Automated Decision-Making: Your personal data will not be processed by automated means, including profiling.
- 11) International Transfers: Your personal data will not be transferred to international organizations or third countries (outside the EEA).
